(1) arson causing death as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 501;

The punishment for murder in the first degree shall be imprisonment for: (A) a minimum term of not less than 35 years and a maximum term of life; or (B) life without the possibility of parole.

(2) assault and robbery with a dangerous weapon as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 608(b);

imprisoned for not more than 15 years nor less than one year.

(3) assault and robbery causing bodily injury as defined in 13 V.S.A. 608(c);

imprisoned for not more than 20 years nor less than one year.

(4) aggravated assault as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 1024;

imprisoned for not more than 15 years or fined not more than \$10,000.00, or both; or imprisoned for not more than five years or fined not more than \$5,000.00, or both, depending on circumstances.

(5) murder as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 2301;

The punishment for murder in the first degree shall be imprisonment for: (A) a minimum term of not less than 35 years and a maximum term of life; or (B) life without the possibility of parole. The punishment for murder in the second degree shall be imprisonment for: (A) a minimum term of not less than 20 years and a maximum term of life; or (B) life without the possibility of parole

(6) manslaughter as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 2304;

fined not more than \$3,000.00, or imprisoned for not less than one year nor more than 15 years, or both.

(7) kidnapping as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 2405;

maximum sentence of life imprisonment or a fine of not more than \$50,000.00, or both.

(8) unlawful restraint as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 2406 or 2407;

Unlawful restraint in the second degree is punishable by imprisonment for not more than five years or a fine of not more than \$25,000.00, or both.

Unlawful restraint in the first degree is punishable by imprisonment for not more than 15 years or a fine of not more than \$50,000.00, or both.

- (9) maiming as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 2701; shall be imprisoned for life or for not less than seven years.
- (10) sexual assault as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 3252(a)(1) or (a)(2);

shall be imprisoned not less than three years and for a maximum term of life, and, in addition, may be fined not more than \$25,000.00.

- (11) aggravated sexual assault as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 3253; or imprisoned not less than ten years and a maximum term of life, and, in addition, may be fined not more than \$50,000.00.
- (12) burglary into an occupied dwelling as defined in 13 V.S.A. § 1201(c).

A person convicted of burglary into an occupied dwelling: (A) shall be imprisoned not more than 25 years or fined not more than \$1,000.00, or both; or (B) shall be imprisoned not more than 30 years or fined not more than \$10,000.00, or both, if the person carried a dangerous or deadly weapon, openly or concealed, during commission of the offense.
