11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 32 V.S.A. § 5870(a) is amended to read:
13	(a) The Commissioner of Taxes shall provide that individuals report use tax
14	on their State individual income tax returns. Taxpayers are required to attest to
15	the amount of their use tax liability under chapter 233 of this title for the period
16	of the tax return. Alternatively, they may elect to report an amount that is a
17	percentage of their Vermont adjusted gross income indexed annually under
18	subsection (b) of this section, as shown on a table published by the
19	Commissioner of Taxes; and use tax liability arising from the purchase of each

item with a purchase price in excess of \$1,000.00 shall be added to the table

1	amount. If a taxpayer reports a use tax liability of zero, the return must include
2	a separate signed statement attesting that the taxpayer purchased no taxable
3	goods subject to the use tax in the applicable tax year.
4	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
5	This act shall take effect on January 1, 2017 and apply to income tax returns

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filed after that date.
