6	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend the
7	laws pertaining to the timelines for budget preparation and adoption of a
8	communications union district.
9	An act relating to the budget process of a communications union district
10	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
11	Sec. 1. 30 V.S.A. § 3075 is amended to read:
12	§ 3075. BUDGET
13	(a) Annually, not later than September 15 on or before October 21, the
14	board shall approve and cause to be distributed to the legislative body of each
15	district member for review and comment an annual report of its activities,
16	together with a financial statement, a proposed district budget for the next
17	fiscal year, and a forecast presenting anticipated year-end results. The
18	proposed budget shall include reasonably detailed estimates of:
19	(1) deficits and surpluses from prior fiscal years;
20	(2) anticipated expenditures for the administration of the district;

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next ensuing fiscal year.

1	(3) anticipated expenditures for the operation and maintenance of any
2	district communications plant;
3	(4) payments due on obligations, long-term contracts, leases, and
4	financing agreements;
5	(5) payments due to any sinking funds for the retirement of district
6	obligations;
7	(6) payments due to any capital or financing reserve funds;
8	(7) anticipated revenues from all sources; and
9	(8) such other estimates as the board deems necessary to accomplish its
10	purpose.
11	(b) Coincident with a regular meeting thereof, the board shall hold a public
12	hearing not later than November 1 on or before November 15 of each year to
13	receive comments from the legislative bodies of district members and hear all
14	other interested persons regarding the proposed budget. Notice of such hearing
15	shall be given to the legislative bodies of district members at least 30 days 15
16	days prior to such hearing. The board shall give consideration to all comments
17	received and make such changes to the proposed budget as it deems advisable.
18	(c) Annually, not later than December 1 on or before December 15, the
19	board shall adopt the budget and appropriate the sums it deems necessary to
20	meet its obligations and operate and carry out the district's functions for the

(d) Actions or resolutions of the board for the annual appropriations of any
year shall not cease to be operative at the end of the fiscal year for which they
were adopted. Appropriations made by the board for the various estimates of
the budget shall be expended only for such estimates, but by majority vote of
the board the budget may be amended from time to time to transfer funds
between or among such estimates. Any balance left or unencumbered in any
such budget estimate, or the amount of any deficit at the end of the fiscal year,
shall be included in and paid out of the operating budget and appropriations in
the next fiscal year. All such budget amendments shall be reported by the
district treasurer to the legislative bodies of each district member within 14
days of the end of the fiscal year.

- (e) Financial statements and audit results shall be delivered to the legislative bodies of each district member within 10 days of delivery to the board.
