As required by Sec. 342.4 of 20 V.S.A §1716, I am reporting on the number of employees at The Vermont Veterans' Home that have worked 16 hours or less per week.

Reasons may be due to illness or other issues, and to cover shifts while full-time employees take vacation or other extended leave time. The exception to this is the receptionist, who was hired to work Saturday and Sunday, we have a full-time receptionist during normal business hours.
