2	The Committee on Ways and Means to which was referred House Bill		
3	No. 870 entitled "An act relating to telecommunications" respectfully reports		
4	that it has considered the same and recommends that the bill be amended as

6	First: By striking out Sec. 4 (capital appropriation for Connectivity		
7	Initiative) in its entirety		
8	Second: In Sec. 5, 30 V.S.A. § 7523, in subsection (b), by striking out		
9	"2020" and inserting in lieu thereof "2021"		
10	<u>Third</u> : By striking out Sec. 10 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a		
11	new Sec. 10 to read as follows:		
12	Sec. 10. PROPOSAL; SCHOOL CONNECTIVITY GRANT PROGRAM		
13	On or before December 1, 2016, the Secretary of Education and the Director		
14	of Telecommunications and Connectivity shall propose to the General		
15	Assembly in the form of a draft bill a school connectivity grant program		
16	designed to provide competitive grants to public schools for capital costs		
17	associated with upgrading the Internet connection to a public school or		
18	purchasing hardware for infrastructure for internal Internet connections. The		
19	goal of the program is to ensure that the maximum Internet service available to		
20	the school is accessible by all personnel and students on school grounds,		
21	consistent with and supportive of educational policies and objectives.		

1	Proposed criteria shall prioritize rural communities having a percentage of		
2	households categorized as low-income that is higher than the State average,		
3	and shall seek to maximize the availability of federal matching funds.		
4	Fourth: By adding a new Sec. 11 and a readers' assistance to read as		
5	follows:		
6	* * * Miscellaneous Provisions; Telecommunications		
7	Grant Programs * * *		
8	Sec. 11. RECOVERY AND REPURPOSING OF		
9	TELECOMMUNICATIONS GRANT FUNDS		
10	To the extent State funds are recovered by the Department of Public		
11	Service, as the successor in interest to the Vermont Telecommunications		
12	Authority (VTA), as the result of a grant recipient's failure to comply with the		
13	terms of a grant agreement entered into with the VTA, such public monies		
14	shall be deposited in the Connectivity Fund.		
15	Fifth: By adding a new Sec. 12 to read as follows:		
16	Sec. 12. HIGH-COST PROGRAM; PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD;		
17	DEADLINE		
18	The Public Service Board shall issue a procedures order for implementation		
19	of the High-Cost Program established under 30 V.S.A. § 7515 not later than		
20	September 1, 2016. If the Board fails to do so, the Board shall provide a report		

1	to the General Assembly and the Governor detailing reasons for failing to		
2	comply with this mandate.
