(b) Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to a person licensed under 18 U.S.C. chapter 44 who is also registered as a Special Occupational Taxpayer under the National Firearms Act of 1934, for the purpose of manufacturing, joint production, calibration, integration, incorporation, testing, permanent and temporary export, permanent and temporary import, research and development, repair, or sale of silencers in accordance with federal, State, and local law.

### **Version 2 (passed after and replaced Version 1):**

(b) Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to a licensed manufacturer, as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 921, who is also registered as a manufacturer pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 5802, for the purpose of manufacturing, joint production, calibration, integration, incorporation, testing, permanent and temporary export, permanent and temporary import, research and development, repair, or sale of silencers in accordance with federal, State, and local law.

## Amendments needed for Version 2: Option A.

(b) Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to a licensed manufacturer or importer, as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 921, who is also registered as a manufacturer or importer, pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 5802, for the purpose of manufacturing, joint production, calibration, integration, incorporation, testing, permanent and temporary export, permanent and temporary import, research and development, repair, or sale of silencers in accordance with federal, State, and local law.

# Amendments to also allow for certain, specially licensed FFLs in Vermont: Option B (same result as Version 1).

(b) Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to a licensed manufacturer, importer, or dealer, as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 921, who is also registered as a manufacturer, importer, or dealer pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 5802, for the purpose of manufacturing, joint production, calibration, incorporation, testing, permanent and temporary export, permanent and temporary import, research and development, repair, or sale of silencers in accordance with federal, State, and local law.
