

1 TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

2 The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred Senate Bill No. 73  
3 entitled “An act relating to rent-to-own agreements for merchandise”  
4 respectfully reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the  
5 House propose to the Senate that the bill be amended as follows:

6 First: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6002(b), by striking out subdivision (4) in its  
7 entirety (legislative members of Vermont Financial Literacy Commission)

8 Second: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6002(b), in subdivision (5), by striking out  
9 the word “public” and by striking out the words “appointed by the Vermont  
10 NEA”

11 Third: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6002(b), in subdivision (6), by striking out  
12 the word “public”

13 Fourth: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6002(b), by striking out subdivision (7) in  
14 its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subdivision (7) to read:

15 (7) one representative focused on collegiate financial literacy issues;

16 and by renumbering the subdivisions in subsection (b) to be numerically  
17 correct

18 Fifth: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6002(d), by adding a subdivision (3) to read:

19 (3) A member of the Commission who is not an employee of the State  
20 of Vermont and who is not otherwise compensated or reimbursed for his or her

1 attendance at a meeting of the Commission shall be entitled to per diem  
2 compensation and reimbursement of expenses pursuant to 32 V.S.A. § 1010.

3 Sixth: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6003(14), by striking out “retired or”

4 Seventh: By adding a Sec. 3A to read:

5 Sec. 3A. REPEAL

6 9 V.S.A. chapter 151 (Vermont Financial Literacy Commission) shall be  
7 repealed on July 1, 2018.

8 and that after passage the title of the bill be amended to read: “An act relating  
9 to consumer protection laws”
