TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred Senate Bill No. 73 entitled "An act relating to rent-to-own agreements for merchandise" respectfully reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the House propose to the Senate that the bill be amended as follows:

First: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6002(b), by striking out subdivision (4) in its entirety (legislative members of Vermont Financial Literacy Commission)

Second: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6002(b), in subdivision (5), by striking out the word "public" and by striking out the words "appointed by the Vermont NEA"

Third: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6002(b), in subdivision (6), by striking out the word "public"

Fourth: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6002(b), by striking out subdivision (7) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subdivision (7) to read: (7) one representative focused on collegiate financial literacy issues;
and by renumbering the subdivisions in subsection (b) to be numerically correct

Fifth: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6002(d), by adding a subdivision (3) to read: (3) A member of the Commission who is not an employee of the State of Vermont and who is not otherwise compensated or reimbursed for his or her
attendance at a meeting of the Commission shall be entitled to per diem compensation and reimbursement of expenses pursuant to 32 V.S.A. § 1010. Sixth: In Sec. 3, in 9 V.S.A. § 6003(14), by striking out "retired or"

Seventh: By adding a Sec. 3A to read:
Sec. 3A. REPEAL
9 V.S.A. chapter 151 (Vermont Financial Literacy Commission) shall be
repealed on July 1, 2018.
and that after passage the title of the bill be amended to read: "An act relating to consumer protection laws"
