8	General Services shall conduct a feasibility study to evaluate the potential uses
9	of the land and building at 195 Colchester Avenue in Burlington, provided that
10	any use shall be consistent with existing deed covenants.
11	Second: In Sec. 11, amending 2015 Acts and Resolves No. 26, Sec. 13, by
12	striking out subsection (d) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
13	(d) The Commissioner of Buildings and General Services is authorized to
14	use up to \$50,000.00 of the amount appropriated in subdivision (c)(1) of this
15	section for acoustical enhancements at the Williston Public Safety Answer
16	Point Center (PSAP), if deemed necessary after consultation with the
17	Department of Public Safety.
18	(e) At the end of the fiscal year, the Commissioner is authorized to use any
19	funds remaining from the amount appropriated in subdivision (c)(1) of this
20	section to evaluate options to replace the Middlesex State Police Barracks.

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1	Third: In Sec. 30, State Correctional Facilities; Committee; Assessment;
2	Report, in subdivision (c)(4), after "public-private partnerships" and before the
3	period, by inserting ", for construction of a facility"
4	Fourth: By adding a Sec. 30a, Vermont State Colleges, to read as follows:

6	Sec. 30a. VERMONT STATE COLLEGES; CAPITAL BUDGET
7	REQUESTS
8	On or before December 15, 2016, the Chancellor of the Vermont State
9	Colleges shall submit a proposal to the House Committee on Corrections and
10	Institutions and the Senate Committee on Institutions outlining the priorities
11	for allocating future capital appropriations between construction, maintenance,
12	and renovation costs at all State Colleges.
13	Fifth: In Sec. 36, State House Security, by striking out subsection (a) in its
14	entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
15	(a) The Sergeant at Arms is authorized to use funds appropriated in Sec. 15
16	of this act to:
17	(1) install a remote lockdown system for doors to the State House;
18	(2) conduct trainings at the State House; and
19	(3) install seven security cameras in the State House.

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1	Sixth: In Sec. 36, State House Security, by striking out subsection (c) in its
2	entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
3	(c) On or before August 1, 2016, the Sergeant at Arms shall develop a
4	camera retention policy and procedure and lockdown guidelines for the State
5	House. The camera retention policy and procedure and lockdown guidelines
6	shall only become effective after unanimous approval by the Senate President
7	Pro Tempore or designee, the Speaker of the House or designee, and the Chairs
8	of the House Committee on Corrections and Institutions and the Senate
9	Committee on Institutions. No cameras shall be installed until the procedures
10	have been approved.
11	Seventh: By adding a Sec. 36a, Repeal, to read as follows:
