Rep. Emmons

I have calculated the costs for operating the electronic monitoring program statewide. I have based the cost on a goal of 60 people per day statewide. A first year cost would be \$727,360.

The total is based on the following.

Month 1- 20 people

Month 2- 40 people

Month 3-12 60 people per month.

In a year that is a total of 19,800 EM days also could be called saved bed days

The cost per day per person would be \$33.20. This is based on \$25.00 to the individual sheriff to provide response/local management, \$5.00 for Windham County to provide 24/7 active monitoring and administration, and \$3.20 to the vendor for the lease of the device.

An additional \$70,000 salary per year for us to have a statewide program monitor

I know this may seem to be a high number, but it is cheaper than a jail bed per year. 60 people for a year would be in excess of \$3.5 million.
