Representative Browning of Arlington moves that the amendment offered by Representative Christie of Hartford be amended as follows:

First: In the second instance of Amendment, in Sec. 17, subsection (a) (integrated education systems), by striking out the following: “On or before July 1, 2019, the State shall provide educational opportunities” and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “The State intends to encourage the provision of educational opportunities”

Second: In the second instance of Amendment, in Sec. 17, subdivision (b)(1) (evaluation), in the first sentence, by striking out the words “Each district shall meet” and inserting in lieu thereof the words “A district may meet”

Third: In the second instance of Amendment, in Sec. 17, subdivision (b)(2) (study committee and report), in the first sentence, by striking out the following: “Except as provided in subsection (e) of this section, each district shall form a study committee” and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “Districts may form a study committee” and also in subdivision (b)(2), by striking out the second sentence beginning with the words “The Report shall” in its entirety

1 Fourth: In the second instance of Amendment, in Sec. 17, subdivision
2 (b)(3) (submission of report and vote of electorate), in the second sentence, by
3 striking out the following: “on or before November 30, 2017”

4 Fifth: In the second instance of Amendment, in Sec. 17, subsection (c),
5 after the internal caption “Size and structure of integrated education systems.”,
6 by inserting the following: “In order to be eligible for incentives under this
7 act, an integrated education system shall adhere the following parameters and
8 receive approval of the State Board of Education pursuant to subsection (d) of
9 this act.”

10 Sixth: In the second instance of Amendment, in Sec. 17, by striking out
11 subsections (e) (exceptions to requirement for study committee), (f) creation of
12 integrated education systems), (g) (interstate school districts), and (h)
13 (protections for nonoperating and operating districts) in their entirety
