16 V.S.A. §2171(a), would be amended to read:

- (a) There is created as a part of the educational system of the State of Vermont a public corporation to be known as “Vermont State Colleges,” or any other name selected by the Board of Trustees at a meeting duly warned for that purpose, ...

2) In addition, either a slip law or addition to the above language would be required to read:

Notwithstanding any name given the Vermont State Colleges by its Board of Trustees, all legal instruments executed in the name of the Vermont State Colleges or any subsequent name determined by the Board of Trustees under 16 V.S.A. §2171(a) shall be legally binding on the corporation. All statutory references to the Vermont State Colleges shall mean the Vermont State Colleges or the same entity however named by the Board of Trustees.
