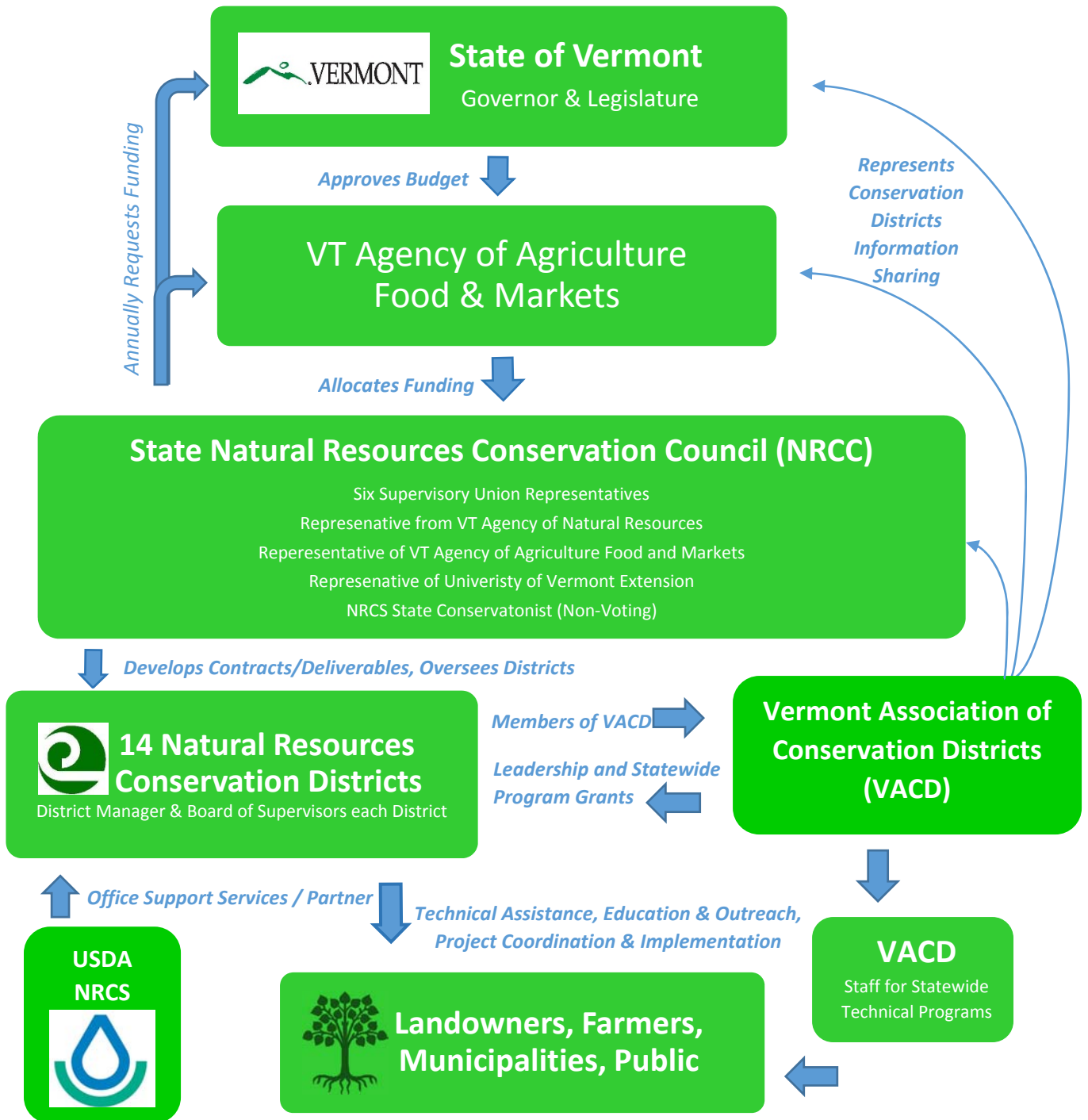


Organizational Chart of Vermont Conservation Districts



Vermont Natural Resources Conservation Districts
 Vermont Statute Title 10: Conservation and Development
 Chapter 31: Soil Conservation Act §§ 701 - 748

1. ASSESS Natural Resource Needs and UNDERSTAND Landowner Concerns

- *District assesses natural resource needs and identifies local priorities.*
- *District solicits landowner input through Local Work Groups and other events.*
- *Expertise of Supervisors and Staff enable district to assess needs and set priorities.*

2. REPRESENT Landowner Concerns

- *District represents landowner concerns in discussion with Vermont Legislators and other policy makers and program managers.*

3. INFORM and EDUCATE the Public

- *District informs the public about natural resource assets, needs, programs and opportunities to participate in addressing natural resource concerns.*

4. IMPLEMENT Projects

- *District implements projects to address natural resource concerns*

Watershed Stewardship – Protecting, restoring and enhancing our water resources

Stormwater Mitigation – Greening of communities through improved development

Sustainable Forestry – Promoting responsible use of working woodlands

Agricultural Water Quality – Improving farm viability while protecting soil & water quality

Education and Outreach – Empowering land stewards with knowledge and expertise

5. Optimize PARTNERSHIPS

- *District expands reach and impact by working closely with other local, state and federal entities*

6. FUNDRAISE and MANAGE District

- *District solicits financial support to address natural resource priorities.*
- *District operations support fulfillment of the district’s mission and conform to legal requirements and best practices.*
