16	(2) The election officials counting ballots and tallying results must shall
17	list every person who receives a "write-in" vote and the number of votes
18	received.
19	(A) On each tally sheet, the counters shall add together the names of
20	candidates that are clearly the same person, even though a nickname or last
21	name is used.
