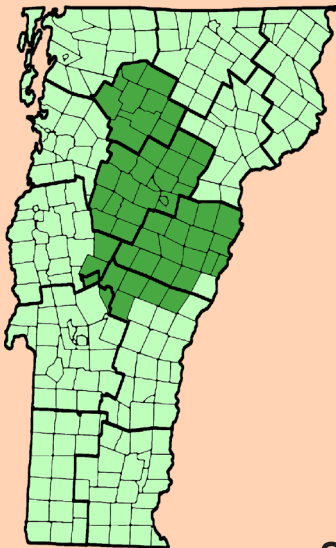

CVCOA's Case Management Team partners with seniors and their families to develop and implement **long-term care plans** to help elders remain in their homes and communities

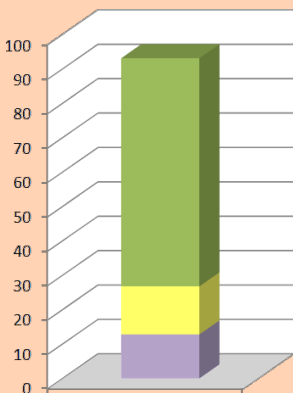


Case Managers work closely with **2500+** seniors every year.

These elders live in **54** towns throughout Central Vermont

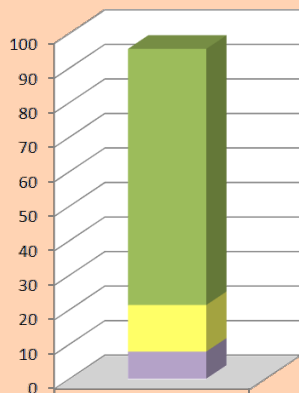
According to a recent survey of seniors working with case managers:

Great Knowledge



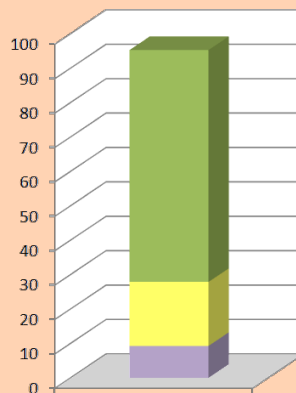
93% see that case managers know available benefits and services

High Quality



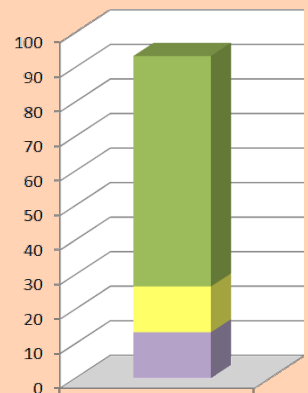
Over 96% feel that services received are of high quality

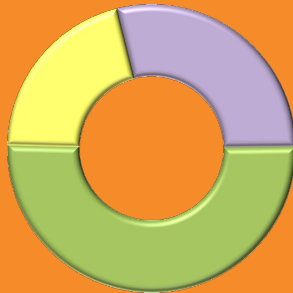
