12	consideration, the Board shall review relevant studies published in
13	peer-reviewed scientific journals and other evidence-based materials and may
14	consult with interested stakeholders and others knowledgeable about the use of
15	complementary and alternative medicine and its application in treating chronic
16	pain or substance use disorder, or both.
