Representative Morris of Bennington moves that the bill be amended by adding a new section to be Sec. 2a to read as follows:

Sec. 2a. 18 V.S.A. § 4219 is added to read:

§ 4219. SIGNATURE REQUIRED FOR DELIVERY OF CERTAIN
PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

(a) A person who delivers commercial goods to residential or commercial addresses, or both, shall obtain the signature of an individual 18 years of age or over at the time of delivery when the product being delivered is a Schedule II, III, or IV opioid controlled substance prescribed for an individual who is receiving hospice care services.

(b) A person who violates the provisions of this section shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000.00 for each Schedule II, III, or IV opioid controlled substance delivered without a signature.
