IF YOU PLEAD ADMITTED OR NO CONTEST: Mark your plea and sign above. Deliver your plea to the Judicial Bureau within 20 days with payment of the WAIVER AMOUNT shown on the front of the Complaint. Pay by check or money order in U.S. funds (make checks payable to JUDICIAL BUREAU) or pay online by credit card. Judgment will be entered against you and any points and suspension required by law will be imposed.

IF YOU PLEAD DENIED: Mark your plea and sign above. Deliver your plea to the Judicial Bureau within 20 days. You will be scheduled to appear in court. You will find more detailed information about appearing in court on the back of the other copy of the complaint, which you should keep for reference.

YOU MUST PAY ONLINE OR DELIVER A PLEA WITHIN 20 DAYS: Otherwise, judgment will be entered against you by default, any points and suspension required by law will be imposed, and you will be liable for the WAIVER AMOUNT, plus a \$20.00 FAILURE TO ANSWER FEE. If you fail to pay the WAIVER AMOUNT, your driver's license and privilege to operate a motor vehicle may be suspended.

IF JUDGMENT IS ENTERED AGAINST YOU:

LITTERING & ILLEGAL DUMPING: You may be ordered to spend up to 80 hours collecting trash. 24 V.S.A. § 2201(c).
DMV POINTS SUSPENSIONS: You will be suspended for 10 days for 10 points, 30 days for 15 points, 90 days for 20 points, and an additional 30 days for each additional 5 points, accumulated within 2 years. If you are found at fault for a traffic accident resulting from a violation, then 2 points will be assessed in addition to the amount shown on the face of this complaint. 23 V.S.A. §§ 2502(b), 2506.

VIOLATION SUSPENSIONS: Sixty days for misusing or counterfeiting plates or documents. 23 V.S.A. § 203. Six months for operating a motor vehicle at 0.02 or more alcohol concentration while under 21 years (suspended 1 year or until age 21 for subsequent violation). 23 V.S.A. § 1216.
