H.40 RECS and Net Metering Joint Ownership Possibility

- 1. Utility and other entity may jointly own 100 percent of a REC.
- 2. Other entity must not count REC toward RESET or other regulatory standard.
- 3. Other entity must be municipality or educational or other nonprofit institution that has approved and is implementing a net zero initiative.
- 4. Face of REC must say it is jointly owned and cannot be transferred without consent of each joint owner.
- 5. REC must be retired; utility counts toward RESET.
- 6. Utility and other entity must make appropriate disclosure about joint REC ownership when making representations; PSB to determine appropriate disclosure.
