Ref. #	Item	Description
1	Carts/containers for Mandatory Recycling	Items include desk-side recycling bins for businesses and recycling curbside bins, carts, and dumpsters.
2	Trucks/cart tippers for Mandatory Recycling	Items include new trucks to allow for the collection of mandatory recyclables, new cart lifters on existing trucks, new transfer trailers to move recyclables from your location to a distant MRF.
3	Transfer Station/Drop-Off Centers for Mandatory Recycling	Facility items include new or modifications to existing drop-off facilities to handle the increase in volume of mandatory recyclables, or new transfer stations to move recyclables out to market or to a distant MRF. Please note if this proposed facility can also handle food residuals as well as yard waste & clean wood.
4	Material Recovery Facilities for Mandatory Recycling	Items include equipment upgrades to existing Material Recovery Facilities.

5	Carts/containers for Food Residuals	Items include food residual collection containers, carts, and dumpsters for residences and businesses.
6	Trucks/cart tippers for Food Residuals	Items include new trucks to allow for the collection of food residuals, new cart lifters on existing trucks, new transfer trailers to move food residuals from your location to an organics processing facility.
7	Transfer Station/Drop-Off Centers for Food Residuals	Facility items include new or modifications to existing drop-off facilities to handle increased volume of food residuals, or new transfer stations to move food residuals out to market or to a distant organics processing facility. Please note if this proposed facility can also handle yard waste & clean wood.
8	Pre-Processing Facility for Food Residuals	Items include equipment to pulp, macerate, remove contaminants, liquefy or store food waste prior to delivery to an organics processing facility.
9	Processing Facility for Food Residuals	Equipment items include: on-site composting/pre-processing units. Facility items include: compost or anaerobic digestion facilities and their related equipment. Please note if this proposed facility can also handle yard waste & clean wood.

Ref. #	Item	Description
10	Trucks for Yard Debris & Clean Wood	Items include new trucks to allow for the collection of mandatory clean wood and yard debris, or new transfer trailers to move material to a wood recycler or processor.
11	Drop-Off Centers for Yard Debris & Clean Wood	Facilities include new or modifications to existing drop-off facilities to handle the increased volume of yard waste and clean wood.
12	Processing Equipment for Yard Debris & Clean Wood	Items include wood chippers, wood grinders, as well as screeners.
