Property Transfer Tax, The current statue:

First 2% goes to the tax department. The remaining 98% is split the following way:

50% to VHCB 33% to the General Fund 17% to Regional Planning Commissions

According to JFO, we have not "withhold" the statutory formula since 2001.

Our proposal is to rework the Property Transfer Tax Formula to:

35% to VHCB 25% to the General Fund 25% to the Water Quality Fund 15% to Regional Planning Commissions

In real terms that would be:



\$12.55 million for VHCB \$8.97 million for the General Fund \$8.97 million to the Water Quality Fund \$5.38 million to Regional Planning Commissions

These numbers would actually represent increases in funding to VHCB and RPCs based on Governor's FY16 proposal.

This financing proposal aims to do a number of things:

- 1. It provides clarity and transparency to how state dollars are spent.
- 2. It continues our investments in VHCB and Regional Planning Commissions at the financial level they have received in recent years.
- 3. It provides a sustainable, long-term, dedicated funding model for Water Quality in Vermont.
