- The Committee on Ways and Means to which was referred House Bill No.
- 3 852 entitled "An act relating to State lands" respectfully reports that it has
- 4 considered the same and recommends that the bill be amended as follows:
- 5 <u>First</u>: In Sec. 1, 10 V.S.A. § 2606b, by striking out subsection (f) in its
- 6 entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 7 (f) There shall be an annual license fee A per tap license charge shall be
- 8 imposed based on the number of taps installed in the license area. The per tap
- 9 fee for a license issued under this section shall be one-quarter of the average of
- 10 the per pound price of Vermont fancy grade syrup and the per pound price of
- 11 Vermont commercial grade syrup as those prices are set on May 1 of each
- 12 year. The fee set each May 1 shall apply to licenses issued by the department
- for the succeeding period beginning June 1 and ending May 31. The
- 14 Commissioner shall establish this per tap license charge at a reasonable rate
- 15 <u>that reflects current market rates.</u> Fees collected under this section shall be
- deposited in the forest parks revolving fund Lands and Facilities Trust Fund
- established under section 2609 of this title and shall be used by the department
- to implement the license program established by this section 3 V.S.A. § 2807.

3	Sec. 3. DEPARTMENT OF FORESTS, PARKS AND RECREATION;
4	WORKING GROUP ON INTERGENERATIONAL TRANSFER OF
5	FORESTLAND
6	(a) On or before August 1, 2016, the Commissioner of Forests, Parks and
7	Recreation shall establish a working group of interested parties to develop
8	recommendations for a statewide program to improve the capacity of providing
9	successional planning technical assistance to forestland owners in Vermont.
10	The working group shall:
11	(1) develop recommended priorities for succession planning for
12	forestland owners;
13	(2) develop strategies for improving conservation investments or
14	incentives that facilitate the intergenerational transfers of intact forestland;
15	(3) develop other strategies for lessening the impact of estate taxes or
16	other pressures that could lead to the breaking up and subdivision of intact
17	forest parcels;
18	(4) develop recommended legislative changes that may be needed to
19	implement its recommendations and strategies; and
20	(5) identify fiscal issues related to its recommendations.

1	(b) On or before February 1, 2017, the Commissioner shall submit a report		
2	to the House Committees on Natural Resources and Energy and on Ways and		
3	Means and the Senate Committees on Natural Resources and Energy and		
4	Finance that shall include the working group's findings and any		
5	recommendations for legislative action.
