## Sec. 3. REPORT TO GENERAL ASSEMBLY; COMBINATION LICENSES FOR FOOD AND LODGING ESTABLISHMENTS

On or before January 15, 2016, the Commissioner of Health, shall submit to the House Committee on Human Services, the House Committee on Ways and Means, the Senate Committee on Finance, a report concerning potential licensing efficiencies including risk-based inspections and combination licenses for food retailers, and food and lodging establishments. The report shall include:

- (1) A summary of how other New England states license such establishments and identify any other state that has a valuable model.
- (2) Describe available models that include risk-based inspections and combination licenses.
- (3) Recommend any revenue-neutral fee structure changes that would improve efficiency for both the Department and licensees.
