First: That the report of the Committee on Natural Resources and Energy be amended, in the eleventh instance of amendment, in Sec. 8 (Public Service Board implementation), by striking out subsection (c) and inserting in lieu a new subsection (c) to read:

(c) ~~Procedures; order~~ Order. On or before July 1, 2016, the Board shall by order adopt initial procedures to implement issue an order that initially implements Secs. 2, 3, and 7 of this act to take effect on January 1, 2017.

Second: That the Senate proposed to the House to amend the bill in Sec. 3, 30 V.S.A. § 8005, in subsection (b) (reduced amounts; providers; 100 percent renewable), in subdivision (1), by striking out subdivision (B) and inserting in lieu thereof a new subdivision (B) to read:

(B) ~~commencing on January 1, 2017~~ annually each July 1 commencing in 2018, owns and has retired tradeable renewable energy credits monitored and traded on the New England Generation Information System or otherwise approved by the Board equivalent to 100 percent of the provider's total retail sales of electricity, ~~calculated as an average on an annual basis for the previous calendar year.~~
