8	(a) On or before September 1, 2017, the State Ethics Commission shall
9	recommend to the General Assembly whether the State should prohibit
10	campaign contributions to candidates for State office and State officers from
11	persons who contract with the State or who bid on such a contract.
12	(b) If the Commission determines that the General Assembly should enact
13	such a prohibition, the Commission's recommendation shall include the
14	following information:
15	(1) Whether there should be a minimum contract amount that would
16	trigger the prohibition.
17	(2) The duration of the prohibition.
18	(3) Whether the prohibition should apply to both persons who bid for a
19	contract and persons who are awarded a contract. If the Commission
20	recommends that persons who bid for a contract should be included in the
21	prohibition, the Commission shall also recommend whether to include

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1	prequalified vendors in the prohibition, and if so, the manner in which the
2	prohibition would apply.
3	(4) If a contractor or prospective contractor is a business entity, whether
4	any principals of the business — such as an individual who has a controlling
5	interest in it — should be included in the prohibition, and whether any family
6	members of an individual who is a contractor, prospective contractor, or
7	principal should be included in the prohibition.
8	(5) Any other information the Commission considers relevant.
