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1 TO THE HONORABLE SENATE:

2	The Committee on Health and Welfare to which was referred Senate Bill
3	No. 190 entitled "An act relating to maintaining prescription drugs outside the
4	original prescription container" respectfully reports that it has considered the
5	same and recommends that the bill be amended by striking out all after the
6	enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
7	Sec. 1. 18 V.S.A. § 4216 is amended to read:
8	§ 4216. AUTHORIZED POSSESSION BY INDIVIDUALS
9	(a) A person to whom or for whose use any regulated drug has been
10	prescribed, sold, or dispensed, and the owner of any animal for which any such
11	drug has been prescribed, sold, or dispensed, may lawfully possess the same on
12	the condition that such drug was prescribed, sold, or dispensed by a physician,
13	dentist, pharmacist, or veterinarian licensed under this chapter to practice in
14	this State or under the laws of another state or country wherein such person has
15	his or her practice, and further that all amounts of the drug are retained in the
16	lawful container in which it was delivered to him or her by the person selling
17	or dispensing the same, provided however, that for the purposes of this section
18	an amount of regulated drugs of not more than two days' individual prescribed
19	dosage may be possessed by a patient for his or her personal use.
20	(b) Notwithstanding the requirement in subsection (a) of this section that a
21	regulated drug be retained in its original container, the individual to whom a

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1	regulated drug was prescribed, dispensed, or sold by a physician, dentist, or
2	pharmacist licensed in Vermont or in another state or country may maintain up
3	to a 14-day supply of the regulated drug outside the original container for his
4	or her own personal use if the following conditions are met:
5	(A) the drug was prescribed for the individual;
6	(B) the individual is in possession of the original or a copy of the
7	prescription label;
8	(C) at all times, the individual intends and has intended to use the
9	drug only for legitimate medical use in conformity with instructions from the
10	prescriber and dispenser; and
11	(D) the individual maintains the limited supply of the drug in a
12	receptacle that reasonably constitutes a more convenient or portable format to
13	enable the individual's legitimate medical use.
14	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
15	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
