13	(6) To maintain and improve the quality of air, water, wildlife, forests,
14	and other land resources.

16	(C) Vermont's forestlands should be managed so as to maintain and
17	improve forest blocks and habitat connectors.

1	(9) To encourage and strengthen agricultural and forest industries.
2	(A) Strategies to protect long-term viability of agricultural and forest
3	lands forestlands should be encouraged and should include maintaining low
4	overall density.

7	Secs. 3 and 4 to read:
8	Sec. 3. 24 V.S.A. § 4348a(a)(2) is amended to read:
9	(2) A land use element, which shall consist of a map and statement of
10	present and prospective land uses, that:
11	(A) indicating Indicates those areas proposed for forests, recreation,
12	agriculture (using the agricultural lands identification process established in
13	6 V.S.A. § 8), residence, commerce, industry, public, and semi-public uses,
14	open spaces, areas reserved for flood plain, and areas identified by the State,
15	regional planning commissions, or municipalities, which that require special
16	consideration for aquifer protection; for wetland protection; for the
17	maintenance of forest blocks, wildlife habitat, and habitat connectors; or for
18	other conservation purposes;.
19	(B) indicating Indicates those areas within the region that are likely

3	(C) indicating Indicates locations proposed for developments with a
4	potential for regional impact, as determined by the regional planning
5	commission, including flood control projects, surface water supply projects,
6	industrial parks, office parks, shopping centers and shopping malls, airports,
7	tourist attractions, recreational facilities, private schools, public or private
8	colleges, and residential developments or subdivisions;
9	(D) setting Sets forth the present and prospective location, amount,
10	intensity, and character of such land uses and the appropriate timing or
11	sequence of land development activities in relation to the provision of
12	necessary community facilities and services;
13	(E) indicating Indicates those areas that have the potential to sustain
14	agriculture and recommendations for maintaining them which may include
15	transfer of development rights, acquisition of development rights, or farmer
16	assistance programs.
17	(F) Indicates those areas that are important as forest blocks and
18	habitat connectors and plans for land development in those areas to minimize
19	forest fragmentation and promote the health, viability, and ecological function
20	of forests. A plan may include specific policies to encourage the active
21	management of those areas for wildlife habitat, water quality, timber

1	production, recreation, or other values or functions identified by the regional
2	planning commission.

20	(C) identifying Identifies those areas, if any, proposed for designation
21	under chapter 76A of this title, together with, for each area proposed for

1	designation, an explanation of how the designation would further the plan's
2	goals and the goals of section 4302 of this title, and how the area meets the
3	requirements for the type of designation to be sought.
4	(D) Indicates those areas that are important as forest blocks and
5	habitat connectors and plans for land development in those areas to minimize
6	forest fragmentation and promote the health, viability, and ecological function
7	of forests. A plan may include specific policies to encourage the active
8	management of those areas for wildlife habitat, water quality, timber
9	production, recreation, or other values or functions identified by the
10	municipality.
