## Ⓥermont Adult Learning

Since July 1, 2006, 4051 students have accessed the High School Completion Program through Learning Works. In that same time, Vermont Adult Learning has served 2658 of these students.

Demographics of HSCP students served by Vermont Adult Learning:

- 1 in 3 students are employed
- Nearly half of VAL students are at or below the poverty line
- Vast majority are between the ages of 16 and 21
