Draft Bill regarding Beer Transfer between Two Breweries Owned By One Company

A brewery located in Vermont may remove beer without payment of tax for transfer to another Vermont brewery of the same ownership, provided that the breweries in question are producing 9300 gallons of beer or more annually. These removals include a removal from a Vermont brewery owned by one company to a Vermont brewery owned by another company if (a) one company owns or has operational control of the other company, or (b) the controlling interest in each company is owned by the same person. The shipping and receiving brewers shall both use invoices showing beer removed without payment of tax in preparing daily records and in preparing the TTB Brewer's Report of Operations.
