

## **Vermont: Essential Findings**

In 2014, Amazon sold **\$90.8 million** worth of retail goods statewide, all while avoiding **\$5.6 million** in state and local sales taxes.

That is the equivalent of **64** retail storefronts, **0.2 million** square feet of commercial space, which might have paid **\$1.1 million** in property taxes.

A total of more than **\$6.7 million** in revenue lost to state and local governments, **\$26.05** for every household in Vermont.

Having no Amazon distribution centers to offset retail job losses, Amazon sales produced a net loss of **556** retail jobs in Vermont.
