TO THE HONORABLE SENATE:

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2	The Committee on Finance to which was referred J.R.H. 1 entitled "Joint
3	resolution expressing support for the Public Service Board's establishment of a
4	FairPoint Communications service investigation docket and urging the
5	management of FairPoint Communications to settle the current employee strike
6	in order to restore reliable telecommunications services in Vermont" has
7	considered the same and recommends that the Senate propose to the House that
8	the resolution be amended by striking it out in its entirety and inserting in lieu
9	thereof the following:
10	Joint resolution expressing support for the Public Board's establishment of
11	a FairPoint Communications service investigation docket and urging the
12	settlement of the current employee strike
13	Whereas, in October 2014, FairPoint and its employees' two unions, the
14	International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 2326 and the
15	Communications Workers of America Local 1400, reached an impasse in their
16	negotiations and a strike was authorized, and
17	Whereas, since the strike started, consumer complaints have risen
18	approximately 500 percent, resulting in much personal and commercial
19	inconvenience, and

1	Whereas, the Vermont Public Service Department has received more than
2	1,200 complaints about Internet and telephone service since the strike
3	began, and
4	Whereas, on November 28, 2014, the State's E-911 system missed
5	83 calls, and
6	Whereas, the Vermont Public Service Department has said that the numbers
7	show FairPoint staffing has been insufficient, and
8	Whereas, FairPoint is the only choice for telecommunications service for
9	between 15,000 and 20,000 Vermonters, and
10	Whereas, at the request of the Department of Public Service, the Public
11	Service Board, on December 9, 2014, established Docket 8390 to investigate
12	the service problems FairPoint has encountered, and
13	Whereas, Governor Peter Shumlin, the congressional delegation, and the
14	leadership of the General Assembly's Working Vermonters Caucus have
15	written letters to FairPoint's CEO Paul Sunu calling on FairPoint to return in
16	good faith to the negotiating table, and
17	Whereas, on January 4, 2015, in Washington, D.C., the Federal Mediation
18	and Conciliation Service convened a meeting between the parties at which the
19	Service assumed a more proactive role than in a prior session, now
20	therefore be it

1	Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives:
2	That the General Assembly expresses support for the Public Service
3	Board's establishment of a FairPoint Communications service investigation
4	docket and urges the settlement of the current employee strike in order to
5	restore reliable telecommunications services in Vermont, and be it further
6	Resolved: That the Secretary of State be directed to send a copy of this
7	resolution to FairPoint Communications CEO Paul Sunu, FairPoint Vermont
8	President Beth Fastiggi, Governor Peter Shumlin, the Public Service
9	Department, the Public Service Board, the International Brotherhood of
10	Electrical Workers Local 2326, and the Communications Workers of America
11	Local 1400.
