2	The Committee on Finance to which was referred Senate Bill No. 75
3	entitled "An act relating to food and lodging establishments" respectfully
4	reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the bill be
5	amended in Sec. 1, by striking out 18 V.S.A. § 4353, subsection (a), in its
6	entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
7	(a) The Commissioner may establish by rule any requirement the
8	Department needs to determine the applicable license fee category or any
9	license exemption. The following fees shall be paid annually to the Board at
10	the time of making the application according to the following schedules:
11	(1) Restaurant I—Seating capacity of 0 to 25; \$105.00
12	II—Seating capacity of 26 to 50; \$180.00
13	III—Seating capacity of 51 to 100; \$300.00
14	IV—Seating capacity of 101 to 200; \$385.00
15	V—Seating capacity of 201 to 599; \$450.00
16	VI—Seating capacity 600 and over; \$1,000.00
17	VII—Home Caterer; \$155.00
18	VIII—Commercial Caterer; \$260.00
19	IX—Limited Operations; \$140.00
20	X—Fair Stand; \$125.00; if operating for four or more
21	days per year; \$230.00

1	(2) Lodging <u>establishments</u>
2	I—Lodging capacity of 1 to 10; \$130.00
3	II—Lodging capacity of 11 to 20; \$185.00
4	III—Lodging capacity of 21 to 50; \$250.00
5	IV—Lodging capacity of 51 to 200; \$390.00
6	V—Lodging capacity of over 200; \$1,000.00
7	VI—Children's camps; \$150.00
8	(3) Food processor manufacturing establishment—a fee for any person
9	or persons that process food for resale to restaurants, stores, or individuals
10	according to the following schedule:
11	(A) Food manufacturing establishments; nonbakeries
12	<u>I</u> —Gross receipts of \$10,001.00 to \$50,000.00;
13	\$175.00
14	(B)II—Gross receipts of over \$50,000.00;
15	\$275.00
16	III—Gross receipts of \$10,000.00 or less are
17	exempt pursuant to section 4358 of this title
18	(B) Food manufacturing establishments; bakeries
19	<u>I—Home bakery; \$100.00</u>
20	II—Small commercial; \$200.00
21	III—Large commercial; \$350.00

1	(4) Seafood vending facility—\$200.00, unless operating pursuant to
2	another license issued by the Department of Health and generating less than
3	\$40,000.00 in seafood gross receipts annually. If generating more than
4	\$40,000.00 in seafood gross receipts annually, the fee is to be paid regardless
5	of whether the facility is operating pursuant to another license issued by the
6	Department of Health.
7	(5) Shellfish reshippers and repackers—\$375.00.
