* Law enforcement agencies may request firearms traces for any reason. Not all firearms used in crime are traced and not all firearms traced are used in crime.

(1) Actual rates calculated. "Per Capita" rates (used in other reports) are an artificial way to inflate the numbers from low population states

(2) & (3) Data inconsistency: ATF states more homicides than FBI recorded.

(4) attempted suicide statistics indicate that using a firearm is NOT always successful.

(5) "Time-To-Crime" stats indicate "Drugs for Guns" is untrue as the length of time from purchase to trace averages a DECADE or more apart.

(6) **Anomaly:** In 2011 two FFL dealers were arrested and their inventory confiscated.

(7) **Anomaly:** In 2013, Vermont law enforcement spent \$150,000 on the largest wave of drug busts the state has ever seen. At least FOUR major raids across the state in 2013 raised the "drug crime" rates.
