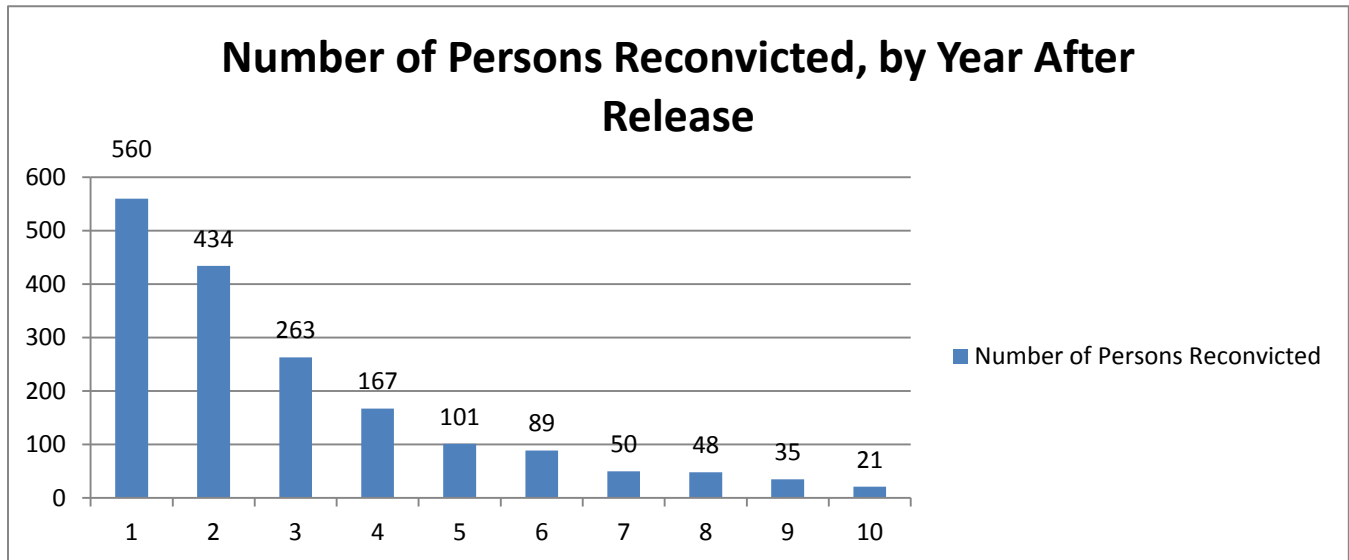




10 Year Recidivism Patterns

Release from a Facility - Recidivism

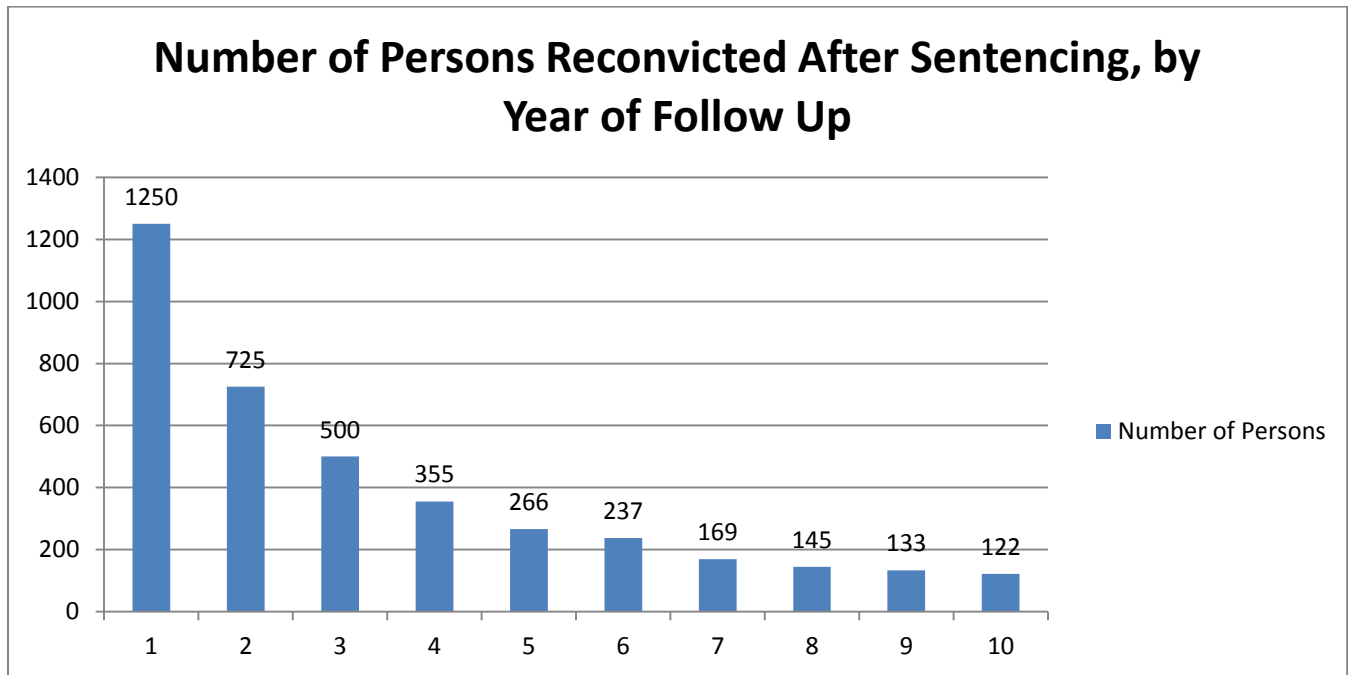
This study followed inmates released from a Vermont Facility in 2000-2004. Criminal Histories were obtained from VCIC and recidivism was calculated as any new conviction during a 10 year follow up period. The total number of inmates in the cohort was 2,807. Of those, 1,039 (37%) did not earn a new conviction during the follow up period. However, 1,768 persons did recidivate. The recidivism rate was 62.9%.

Sentenced to Probation - Recidivism

This study followed defendants sentenced to probation in 2000-2004. Criminal Histories were obtained from VCIC and recidivism was calculated as any new conviction during a 10 year follow up period. The total number of inmates in the cohort was 9,510. Of those, 5,608 (58.9%) did not earn a new conviction during the follow up period. However, 3,902 persons did. The recidivism rate was 41%.
