14	(15) Solar plants; setbacks; screening. Notwithstanding any contrary
15	provision of section 4413 of this title or 30 V.S.A. chapter 5 or 89, a
16	municipality may adopt bylaws that require a plant that generates electricity
17	from solar energy to comply with setback and screening requirements. These
18	requirements shall not prohibit or have the effect of prohibiting the installation
19	of such a plant and shall not have the effect of interfering with its intended
20	functional use. In this section, "plant" shall have the same meaning as in
