

Poverty Reduction Framework

- Shoring up the safety net (basic assistance, nutrition, housing, etc.)
- Making work pay (wages, child care, transportation, EITC, health, etc.)
- Addressing barriers to self-sufficiency (mental health, substance abuse, criminal



Building on existing programs

- TANF (Reach Up) – benefit levels, cliff effect, education and training
- SNAP – outreach, education and training
- Home visiting
- Early learning– CCDBG reauthorization, Head Start
- Employment – WIOA, TANF post-
