## Calculating Departure/Retirement Savings

AoE analysis, which excludes special education paraprofessionals, leaves about 4,000 paraprofessionals in the refined counts; all other staff make up about 10,700 bringing the total to about 14,700.

To determine retirements/departures, we used a split proportional to the total FTEs (after exclusions):

**Paraprofessionals**: 4,000/14,700 = 27% of departures (unfilled vacancies of 108 out of 400 in FY19/20);

All Other Staff: 10,700/14,700 = 73% of departures (unfilled vacancies of 292 out of 400 in FY19/20);

Average salary and benefits for "other staff" is approximately \$76,000, and for paraprofessionals is approximately \$30,000. Our calculation considers that one typically earns 20-25% above the mean salary and benefit level at the time of retirement.

### These calculations yield a savings range of:

(108) (1.2 x \$30,000) AND (108) (1.25 x 30,000) = 3.89 - 4.05 million (292) (1.2 x \$76,000) AND (292) (1.25 x 76,000) = 26.6 - 27.75 million DRAFT
