Act No. 39 (S.14). Health; Vermont Practitioner Recovery Network

An act relating to expanding the Vermont Practitioner Recovery Network

This act expands the existing Vermont Practitioner Recovery Network to include evaluations and coordination of services for licensees who have or potentially have an impaired ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety. Affected licensees include podiatrists, physicians, anesthesiologist assistants, physician assistants, and radiologist assistants. The act also waives licensure fees for physicians practicing in Vermont solely for the purpose of volunteering services through the Vermont Medical Reserve Corps.

Effective Date: July 1, 2017
