## No. 138. An act relating to Medicaid reimbursement for long-acting reversible contraceptives.

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
Sec. 1. 33 V.S.A. § 1901 j is added to read:
§ 1901j. MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT FOR LONG-ACTING

## REVERSIBLE CONTRACEPTIVES

(a) As used in this section, "health care provider" has the same meaning as
in 18 V.S.A. § 9402.
(b) The Department of Vermont Health Access shall reimburse health care providers for the full cost of a device providing long-acting reversible contraception when the device is inserted during a Medicaid beneficiary's postpartum hospital stay.

Sec. 2. COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN OVER-THE-COUNTER CONTRACEPTIVES; REPORT
(a) Each health insurer offering qualified health benefit plans through the Vermont Health Benefit Exchange shall, in consultation with its pharmacy benefit manager, if any, determine how to provide coverage for over-thecounter oral contraceptives and over-the-counter emergency contraceptives in its Exchange and non-Exchange plans without requiring a prescription and without imposing cost-sharing requirements.
(b) On or before January 15, 2019, each health insurer shall report to the
