Act No. 146 (H.718). Crimes and criminal procedures; corrections

An act relating to creation of the Restorative Justice Study Committee

This act creates the Restorative Justice Study Committee for the purpose of conducting a comprehensive examination of whether there is a role for victim-centered restorative justice principles and processes in domestic and sexual violence and stalking cases. The Vermont Network Against Domestic and Sexual Violence will staff the Committee and submit an interim written report to the House Committee on Corrections and Institutions and to the House and Senate Committees on Judiciary by December 1, 2018 and a final report by July 1, 2019.
