14	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
15	Sec. 1. 8 V.S.A. chapter 107, subchapter 15 is added to read:
16	Subchapter 15. Enteral Formula
17	§ 41001. NONPRESCRIPTION ENTERAL FORMULA FOR HOME USE
18	(a) A health insurance plan shall provide coverage for nonprescription
19	elemental enteral formula for home use if:

1	(1) the formula is medically necessary for the treatment of impaired
2	absorption of nutrients caused by one or more disorders affecting the
3	absorptive surface, functional length, or motility of the gastrointestinal tract;
4	(2) the prescribing physician has issued a written order for the
5	formula; and
6	(3) the formula comprises the sole source, or an essential source, for
7	meeting the patient's nutritional needs.
8	(b) Coverage for nonprescription elemental enteral formula shall not be
9	subject to any greater co-payment, coinsurance, deductible, or other
10	cost-sharing requirement than that applicable to any other benefit covered
11	under the health insurance plan.
12	(c) As used in this section, "health insurance plan" means a health
13	insurance policy or health benefit plan offered by a health insurer, as defined
14	in 18 V.S.A. § 9402, that is licensed to do business in Vermont, but does
15	not include policies or plans providing coverage for a specified disease or other
16	limited benefit coverage.
17	Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE
18	This act shall take effect on October 1, 2017 and shall apply to all health
19	benefit plans on and after October 1, 2017, on such date as a health insurer
20	offers, issues, or renews the health benefit plan, but in no event later than
21	October 1, 2018.
