Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to establish a  
private right of action against unpermitted salvage yards.

An act relating to a private right of action against unpermitted salvage yards

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 24 V.S.A. § 2281 is amended to read:

§ 2281. INJUNCTIVE RELIEF; OTHER REMEDIES; PRIVATE RIGHT OF  
ACTION

(a) In addition to the penalty in section 2282 of this title, the legislative  
body may seek a temporary restraining order, preliminary injunction, or  
permanent injunction against the establishment, operation, or maintenance of a  
salvage yard which is in violation of the relevant municipal requirements of  
this subchapter and may obtain compliance with the relevant municipal  
requirements of this subchapter and the terms of a certificate of approved

1 location issued under this subchapter by complaint to the Environmental  
2 Division for the county in which the salvage yard is located.

3 (b) In addition to the penalty in section 2282 of this title, the Agency of  
4 Transportation may seek appropriate injunctive relief in the Superior Court to  
5 enforce the provisions of this subchapter within its regulatory authority.

6 (c) An owner of property abutting a salvage yard shall have a private right  
7 of action for damages and injunctive relief against the owner or operator of the  
8 salvage yard if:

9 (1) the owner or operator of the salvage yard does not hold the  
10 certificates of approval and registration required by section 2242 of this  
11 title; and

12 (2) the abutting property owner shows by a preponderance of the  
13 evidence that the salvage yard caused a diminution in value of the abutting  
14 property owner's property.
