13	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
14	Sec. 1. 18 V.S.A. § 4801 is amended to read:
15	§ 4801. DECLARATION OF POLICY
16	(a) It is the policy of the State of Vermont that alcoholism and alcohol
17	abuse are correctly perceived as health and social problems rather than
18	criminal transgressions against the welfare and morals of the public.

1	(b) The General Assembly therefore declares that:
2	(1) alcoholics and alcohol abusers shall no longer be subjected to
3	criminal prosecution solely because of their consumption of alcoholic
4	beverages or other behavior related to consumption which is not directly
5	injurious to the welfare or property of the public; and
6	(2) alcoholics and alcohol abusers shall be treated as sick persons and
7	shall be provided adequate and appropriate medical and other humane
8	rehabilitative services congruent with their needs.
9	(c) This section shall not be construed to limit or affect the validity of any
10	criminal statute or any condition of probation or release related to alcohol
11	consumption.
12	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
13	This act shall take effect on passage.
