7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to provide
8	greater flexibility for school district consolidation by providing tax incentives
9	for a side-by-side regional educational district structure where three or more
10	school districts merge and the newly merged district, together with a
11	pre-existing district, are members of the same supervisory union at the
12	completion of the consolidation process.

14	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

16	Sec. 15. TWO OR MORE MERGERS; REGIONAL EDUCATION
17	DISTRICT INCENTIVES
18	(a) Notwithstanding Sec. 3(a)(1) of No. 153 of the Acts of the 2009
19	Adj. Sess. (2010) 2010 Acts and Resolves No. 153, Sec. 3(a)(1) that requires a
20	single regional education district ("RED") to have an average daily

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1	membership of at least 1,250 or result from the merger of at least four districts,
2	or both, two or more <u>each</u> new districts <u>district</u> shall be eligible jointly for the
3	incentives provided in Sec. 4 of No. 153, Sec. 4 if:
4	(1) <u>Either:</u>
5	(A) two or more new districts are formed (each a Merged District)
6	and are members of the same supervisory union at the completion of the
7	consolidation process, with each new district is Merged District formed by the
8	merger of at least two existing districts (Dual Merger Model); or
9	(B) one district is newly formed by the merger of at least three
10	existing districts (Merged District) and the other district is an existing district
11	(Existing District), and the Merged District and the Existing District are
12	members of the same supervisory union at the completion of the consolidation
13	process (Single Merger Model).
14	(2) each new district meets Each Merged District in the Dual Merger
15	Model and each of the Merged District and the Existing District in the Single
16	Merger Model meet all criteria for RED formation other than the size criterion
17	of 2010 Acts and Resolves No. 153, Sec. 3(a)(1) of No. 153; (average daily
18	membership of at least 1,250) and otherwise as provided in this section.
19	(3) one of the new districts provides education in all elementary and
20	secondary grades by operating one or more schools and the other new district
21	or districts pay tuition for students in one or more grades;

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1	(4) each new district Each Merged District in the Dual Merger Model
2	has the same effective date of merger;.
3	(5) the new districts, when merged, are members of one supervisory
4	union; and
5	(6)(4) the new districts The Merged Districts in the Dual Merger Model,
6	and the Merged District and the Existing District in the Single Merger Model,
7	jointly satisfy the size criterion of Sec. 3(a)(1) of No. 153 have an average
8	daily membership of at least 1,250.
9	(b) This section is repealed on July 1, 2017 Each Merged District in the
10	Dual Merger Model, and each of the Merged District and the Existing District
11	in the Single Merger Model, may operate schools for one or more grades, may
12	pay tuition for one or more grades, or may operate schools for some grades and
13	pay tuition for other grades.
14	(c) The tax incentives provided in 2010 Acts and Resolves No. 153, Sec. 4
15	shall be available to each Merged District and shall not be available to an
16	Existing District.

7	(B) is a regional education district or <u>a member</u> of any other district
8	eligible to receive incentives governance structure formed pursuant to 2010
9	Acts and Resolves No. 153, as amended by 2012 Acts and Resolves No. 156
10	and as further amended by this act, or pursuant to 2012 Acts and Resolves No.
11	156 as amended by this act.
