8	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to create a new
9	crime of organized retail theft.

11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 13 V.S.A. § 2575a is added to read:
13	§ 2575a. ORGANIZED RETAIL THEFT
14	(a) A person commits the offense of organized retail theft when he or she
15	commits the offense of retail theft pursuant to section 2575 of this title and:
16	(1) he or she acts in concert with two or more persons on one or more
17	occasions within a period of 180 days; and
18	(2) the aggregate value of the merchandise obtained has a retail value of
19	not less than \$2,500.00.

1	(b) A person convicted of organized retail theft of merchandise having an
2	aggregate retail value of not less than \$2,500.00 and not more than \$5,000.00
3	shall be imprisoned not more than five years or fined not more than \$5,000.00,
4	or both. A person convicted of organized retail theft of merchandise having an
5	aggregate retail value greater than \$5,000.00 shall be imprisoned not more than
5	ten years or fined not more than \$10,000.00, or both.

3	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
