7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to eliminate the
8	excess spending penalty for fiscal year 2018 for a school district that satisfies
9	certain conditions.
10	An act relating to an excess spending penalty for fiscal year 2018
11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. TEMPORARY RELIEF FROM EXCESS SPENDING PENALTY
13	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for fiscal year 2018 only, a
14	school district shall not incur a penalty for excess spending, as defined under
15	32 V.S.A. § 5401(12), if the following conditions are satisfied:
16	(1) on or before January 1, 2017, the district was part of a study
17	committee formed under 16 V.S.A. § 706;
18	(2) between January 1, 2017 and July 1, 2017, the electorate of the
19	district voted on a proposal to merge the district under 2015 Acts and Resolves
20	No. 46; and

1	(3) the district:
2	(A) pays tuition for grade 7 through grade 12;
3	(B) had actual expenditures for fiscal year 2017 that exceeded its
4	fiscal year 2017 voter-approved budget, due to students moving into the
5	district for which the district incurred tuition payment expenses after the fiscal
6	year 2017 budget was approved by the district's electorate; and
7	(C) would incur a penalty for excess spending for fiscal year 2018 as
8	a result of the additional tuition payment expenses the district incurred in fiscal
9	<u>year 2017.</u>
10	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
11	This act shall take effect on passage.
