Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to establish the
crime of possession of heroin with the intent to sell.

An act relating to possession of heroin with the intent to sell

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 18 V.S.A. § 4233 is amended to read:

§ 4233. HEROIN

* * *

(b) Selling or dispensing; possessing with intent to sell.

(1) A person knowingly and unlawfully dispensing heroin shall be
imprisoned not more than three years or fined not more than \$75,000.00, or
both. A person knowingly and unlawfully selling heroin, or possessing heroin
with the intent to sell it, shall be imprisoned not more than five years or fined
not more than \$100,000.00, or both.
