5	after March 1, 2014, when requiring prior authorization for prescription drugs,

9	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
10	This act shall take effect on October 1, 2017 and shall apply to health
11	insurance plans on or after October 1, 2017 on such date as a health insurer
12	issues, offers, or renews the health insurance plan, but in no event later than
13	<u>October 1, 2018.</u>
