Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the Agency of Human Services to evaluate the effectiveness of existing programs and initiatives established by or implemented in partnership with the Department of Health, the Department for Children and Families, the Blueprint for Health, and other State entities, independently or in collaboration with health care providers and other community partners, to expand access to and use of long-acting reversible contraceptives in Vermont.
