Subject: Health; health care professionals; medical judgment

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to establish a
statutory framework to ensure that health care professionals in Vermont retain
the unfettered ability to exercise their independent medical judgment,
regardless of their affiliation, if any, with a hospital, health insurer,
accountable care organization, health clinic, or other public or private entity.
It would also allow Vermont patients to opt out of having an electronic health
record and other electronic transmission of their health care information.
